### DRESSAGE

1. 'Prelim 7 in Pink' – How pink can you and your horse be?  
Extra marks for pinkness! (Proceeds to Breast Cancer Research)
2. 'Have a Go Class!' – MARC Walk&Trot 1. Open to anyone who hasn't scored above 65%. \*Any tack & clothing permitted (**in this class only**).
3. Pairs Walk & Trot . Pony Club D Test. Stick together, side by side.
4. Prix Caprilli ESRC version, available on request. Simple dressage test to include 2 jumps approx. 1'6" placed on ¾ lines.
5. Dog Dressage - MARC W&T 2. (in reduced size arena)

### SHOWING

1. Fancy Dress Any costume. People in pink from dressage class 1 may enter. (Proceeds to Breast Cancer Research)
2. Ridden Cutest Pony/Horse and Rider.
3. Ridden or In Hand Hairiest mane, tail, legs (Horse's legs, not the rider!)
4. Ridden or In Hand Prettiest Markings. Colours, spots, stripes!
5. Pairs Look Alike. 2 Riders, 2 horses or ponies turned out as a pair. Both pink perhaps? !!
6. Little and Large One rider on a large horse, one rider on a small pony to do a ridden display side by side.
7. Worst Turned Out. Scruffy, muddy and torn is the fashion in this class!

### JUMPING

1. Six Legs 1'6" One person to jump the course on foot first, one to ride the course, both against the clock.
2. Two Phase. 2' Jump a clear round, stay in ring for immediate jump off.
3. Barrel Jumping. Jump a row of barrels until 1 remains.
4. Tag Pairs 2'3" One after another against the clock.
5. Pairs Together 2'3" Marks out of 10 for togetherness over each jump.
6. Horse & Hound ('By Popular Demand!)\_Horse &\_rider jump part of course followed by dog against the clock.
7. Top Score Jumping 2'3"- 3' Jumps score points. With 'Joker' fence.
8. Tag Pairs 2'6" – 2'9". One after another against the clock.
9. Chase Me Charlie Who can jump the highest ?

4. Prix Caprilli ESRC version, available on request. Simple dressage test to include 2 jumps approx. 1'6" placed on ¾ lines.
5. Dog Dressage- MARC W&T 2. (in reduced size arena)

4. Tag Pairs 2'3" One after another against the clock.
5. Pairs Together 2'3" Marks out of 10 for togetherness over each jump.
6. Horse & Hound ('By Popular Demand!)\_Horse &\_rider jump part of course followed by dog against the clock.
7. Top Score Jumping 2'3"- 3' Jumps score points. With 'Joker' fence.
8. Tag Pairs 2'6" – 2'9". One after another against the clock.
9. Chase Me Charlie Who can jump the highest ?
